

DICTIONARY TASK (5%)

Instructions:

1. While you are reading a passage or passages from a book, a magazine, or a newspaper as one part of your portfolio, select and highlight or circle at least ten words from the reading passage(s) whose meaning you don't know. Make sure that you select the key words, the ones that carry important meaning.
2. Look up those words in an English-English dictionary (e.g. Longman Active Study Dictionary, Collins Cobuild English Language Dictionary, or Oxford Advanced Learner's Dictionary).
3. Study the definition of the words and take notes containing the following information:
 - 3.1 pronunciation
 - 3.2 grammatical information (select the part of speech and the usage relevant to the passage)
 - 3.3 meaning (select the meaning used in the passage)
 - 3.4 example (select an example relevant to the meaning)
4. Take notes using the **Note Form** given below.
5. Submit your notes of the ten selected words as well as the reading passage(s) to your teacher.
