

## Types of questions

Different ways of asking questions:

1. Yes/No -> out put: percentage

Example: *Is the Mercedes-Benz the best car?*    Yes     No

2. Closed set -> output: percentage

Example: *What car is the safest?* \_ \_ \_ \_ \_

3. Rating scale -> output: frequency tables

Example: *How often do you drive upcountry?*

*frequently*     *seldom*     *rarely*     *never*

4. Ranking -> output: scale of ranking

Example: *Rank the follow cars in order of costs*

*Mitsubishi*    *Volvo*    *Audi*    *BMW*    *Rolls-Royce*  
               

5. Open set question -> output: frequency

Example: *In your opinion, what factors influence new car sales?*

6. Multiple choice -> output: frequency/ percentage

Example: *What car do you think has the best design?*

*Alfa-Romeo*     *Jaguar*     *Ferrari*
